C.G. Jung's *RED BOOK*The Journey of the Soul

"I accepted the chaos, and in the following night, my soul approached me." C.G. Jung

Liber Novus or *New Book*, as Jung titled the work, recounts and comments on the author's imaginative experiences between 1913 and 1916. This elaborately illustrated *Red Book*, complete with hand-illuminated text, tells the story of how Jung discovers his soul and thus brings meaning to his life. Through this journey into his own unconscious, Jung was introduced to many ideas that later became "Jungian" psychology. In short, the *Red Book* tells the story of how Jung became Jung.

We will explore this fascinating work by discussing four topics as they relate to the *Red Book*: (1) Art history and imagery sources, (2) major concepts influencing the Red Book, (3) analysis of text and images, and (4) analysis of transpersonal art images created by the presenter, Jim Slouffman.

Our learning experience will be supported by use of images from the *Red Book* and quotes by C.G. Jung and other *Red Book* authorities. We will also explore the creative process in a personal way and see how it relates to Jung's own creative process by presenting and discussing Jim Slouffman's art images in his Green Book.

About our presenter:

Jim Slouffman has been an artist and educator for over 40 years. Jim received a BFA from Wright State University and his MFA degree from the University of Cincinnati. He taught for 31 years at Antonelli College, Cincinnati, Ohio. Jim has held One-man shows of his paintings and drawings at numerous galleries and colleges throughout the U.S. In retirement, he now devotes the majority of his time between two arts organizations he founded: the Kolping Saengerchor (German Chorus) and the Wagner Society of Cincinnati. He is a Dayton, Ohio native.
